Greater Hickory Cooperative Christian Ministry Intake Representative - Spanish Speaking Job Description

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Responsible for client intake and eligibility for program areas.

ACCOUNTABILITY: Supervised by and reports directly to the Crisis Services Coordinator.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A. Education: AA degree in social work, sociology, psychology, management or the social sciences preferred. High school diploma required.
- B. Skills: Ability to assess, problem solve and case manage a variety of social, economic and health problems. Competence in planning, development and referrals to meet client needs. Ability to network with other service providers. Computer competency is required. Bilingual Spanish required.
- C. Work Experience: Minimum one year casework experience preferred. Background and knowledge in areas related to client services, external agency services, referrals, mental health, substance abuse, care of the elderly and/or case management strongly preferred. Minimum 2 years clerical experience required.
- D. Personal Qualities:
 - 1. Ability to relate to a variety of people in a friendly, diplomatic, and professional manner.
 - 2. Good communication skills, both verbal and written.
 - 3. Be energetic, self-motivated and organized.
 - 4. Be able to handle emotional situations in a calm and kind manner.
 - 5. Be able to assess, analyze, and solve independently a wide variety of moderately difficult situations and problems.
 - 6. Be flexible and creative and able to work in a team environment.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBLITIES:

- 1. Assure that clients are served with dignity, respect, and professionalism.
- 2. Interview clients. Analyze information to determine eligibility.
- 3. Review client files to assure properly completed, and returned to appropriate place.
- 4. Check records of pledges made and submit to CFO for payment.
- 5. Be available to fill in at the receptionist counter when needed.
- 6. Provide additional case management and referrals within agency guidelines.
- 7. Adhere to organization's policies and procedures.
- 8. Cross train to perform in Food Pantry and Thrift Store to assist to fill gaps in coverage.
- 9. Assist with department specific fund raising activities and events. Encouraged to participate in agency at large events.
- 10. Assist agency with translation needs for flyers, brochures, other materials and with language needs of Spanish speaking clients.
